Wireless Service Coming to Metro

"Metrorail riders soon will be able to use four major cell phone providers to make calls or access the Internet from 20 of Metro's busiest underground stations.

Verizon Wireless, Sprint Nextel, AT&T and T-Mobile began installing hardware at designated Metrorail stations that will allow Metrorail customers to make calls, send text messages or surf the Web from 20 stations starting Friday, October 16.

During the next 2 months, the companies will install a wireless network at the following stations: Ballston, Bethesda, Columbia Heights, Crystal City, Dupont Circle, Farragut North, Farragut West, Federal Triangle, Foggy Bottom-GWU, Friendship Heights, Gallery Pl-Chinatown, Judiciary Square, L'Enfant Plaza, McPherson Square, Metro Center, Pentagon, Pentagon City, Rosslyn, Smithsonian and Union Station."

K&K Connections, LLC Safety Corner Merging Safely

Here are important steps to remember when merging onto the highway:

1. Make sure you are going at the same speed as the traffic you are merging with before you hit the point at which the ramp merges with the highway. This is very important so that those coming up behind you on the highway do not hit you from behind.
2. Put your turn signal on so that the cars on the highway know you are merging into their lane.
3. Look first in your driver's side rearview mirror and then quickly glance out towards the left and behind you to see if there is any car in your blind spot. Then quickly check to see if someone has stopped in the merge lane in front of you.
4. Determine if you have room to merge onto the highway, if you don't you will have to speed up or down until you have ample space to merge into.
5. Gradually, never abruptly, merge into the lane, following the natural path of the merging ramp. Make sure to maintain your speed, which should be the same speed as the cars in the right lane on the highway.
