- Are You Practicing These Important Safety Precautions?

- Rain is a common spring hazard. Rain lifts oil and other fluids making roads very slick. Also, rain dampens visibility. Slow down and use just as much caution in the rain as you would in ice and snow.
• To avoid hydroplaning check to make sure tires are in good condition before each trip, slow down, avoid puddles, and try to drive in the tracks left in cars in front of you.
• During extreme rain or flash flooding , know the depth of water in a dip before crossing. Be aware that the road bed may not be intact under the water.
