New Maximum Benefit for the Transportation Incentive Program

The \$230 maximum benefit established by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and extended under the Tax Relief Unemployment Insurance Reauthorization and Job Creation Act of 2010 is set to expire on December 31, 2011. The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) plans to publish an inflation adjustment to the original mass transit benefit amount in their November 7, 2011, IRS Bulletin. The inflation-adjusted, new maximum benefit for the Transportation Incentive

Program will be \$125 per month. This adjusted amount will take effect on January 1, 2012.

There is always the potential that Congress may take additional action to change the maximum benefit amount. Any congressional action will take effect at the next regularly scheduled distribution destinations.
