SPECIAL NOTICE: New Emergency Ride Home Program Guidelines

All members are required to re-apply to the ERH Program for 2011, even if they have been registered for years.

The Emergency Ride Home (ERH) program sponsored by Ridefinders, a division of GRTC, provides eligible, enrolled commuters who carpool; vanpool; bike; or ride the bus to work at least 3 days a week with a ride home or to your vehicle if an emergency occurs while at work.
